Second Global Foil Roller Conference in 2011

Stefan Glimm, EAFA Executive Director: "The common understanding to further explore and to ensure the global messages on foil's contribution to sustainable consumption resulted in a mutual communication project which is now under preparation. We expect the launch towards the mid of 2010."

Thailand was chosen for the conference because of its location close to the largest aluminium foil markets Europe and Asia.

The conference is organised by the European Aluminium Foil Association (EAFA) and sponsored by the worldwide leading supplier for foil mills, Achenbach Buschhütten, and Novelis PAE, a world leader in the development of technologies for molten metal treatment and continuous aluminium casting.
